The Club Trials event is open to novice, intermediate and advanced drivers. All participants will receive a minimum of four 20 minute sessions in run groups with other drivers of their same skill level. Instruction will be available. Open cars must have roll bars and arm restraints. This will not be a timed event.

All participants will be required to work a position at the event for part of the day – such as corner worker, grid, tech, control, or instructor (for those qualified).
