Solo, also called Autocross, is a timed contest of driving skill. Speeds and hazards to spectators, participants, and property do not exceed those found in normal, legal highway driving. We think it is much more fun than street driving and you can't get a speeding ticket! Best of all, you can enter in your everyday street car!

This school will introduce you to Solo driving, teach you some of valuable driving skills and give you a chance to try them out in a controlled environment. There will be classroom and in car instruction from experienced drivers and coaches.

Reno SCCA Events are open to all licensed drivers and mechanically sound cars. (Sorry, no SUVs or other tall vehicles.)

Cost: \$25 event fee + \$15 weekend membership for non-SCCA Members.

Schedule: Please plan to arrive by 8:00AM to get registered and have your car inspected before the classroom session begins at 9:00 and plan to be there until at least 4:00PM
