

- 5) Remove radiator fan motor assembly.
- 6) Remove fan motor from shroud.

B: INSTALLATION

Installation is in the reverse order of removal procedures. Do the following:


- 1) Before installing radiator fan motor, apply a coat of sealant to threads and tighten nuts.
- 2) Make sure radiator fan does not come into contact with shroud when installed.
- 3) After installation, make sure there is no unusual noise or vibration when fan is rotated.


7. Engine Coolant Pipe

A: REMOVAL


1) Release fuel pressure. <Ref. to 2-8 [W1A0].>

2) Disconnect ground cable from the battery.






3) Drain engine coolant completely. <Ref. to 2-5 [W1A0].>




4) Remove intake manifold. <Ref. to 2-7 [W4A0].>


SERVICE PROCEDURE




5) Disconnect heater inlet hose.



6) Disconnect radiator inlet hose from engine coolant pipe.



7) Remove bolts which install engine coolant pipe on cylinder block.



B: INSTALLATION


1) Install engine coolant pipe on cylinder block.

Tightening torque:


6.4±0.5 N·m (0.65±0.05 kg-m, 4.7±0.4 ft-lb)

CAUTION:


Use a new O-ring.




2) Connect radiator inlet hose.



3) Connect heater inlet hose.



4) Install intake manifold. <Ref. to 2-7 [W4D0].>



5) Connect ground cable to battery terminal.
