
6. Muffler

A: REMOVAL

1) Separate the muffler (RH) from rear exhaust pipe.




2) Remove the cushion rubbers, and detach the muffler.

CAUTION:

Be careful not to drop the muffler during removal.

NOTE:

To facilitate removal, apply a coat of spray type lubricant to the mating area of cushion rubbers in advance.



3) Perform the same procedure for muffler (LH).

B: INSTALLATION


Install in the reverse order of removal.

NOTE:

Always use a new gasket and self-locking nuts.

Tightening torque:

48 N·m (4.9 kgf-m, 35.4 ft-lb)



C: INSPECTION

1) Check the connections and welds for exhaust leaks.

- 2) Check the mufflers for holes or rust.
- 3) Check the cushion rubber for wear or crack.
